Here are just a few simple things you can do to improve the energy efficiency and comfort of your home as warmer temperatures arrive:

- Set thermostat at 72°F or higher
- Cool only rooms you use and close off unused rooms
- Clean or replace cooling filters monthly
- Close drapes to block out the sun and make sure drapes do not block vents
- Insulate your attic
- Shade outdoor air conditioning equipment and keep it low to the ground to reduce energy consumption by 40% or more
- Use a portable fan or ceiling fan to circulate air and make a breeze
- Wash full loads in your dishwasher and let the dishes air dry to reduce your dishwasher's energy usage by 40%
