
BUDGET BILLING



Quick & Easy Winter Energy Tips

Seal up the drafts.

Weather stripping can save you up to 10% on your total energy bill.

Use electric space heaters sparingly.

They are expensive to run and should be closely monitored.

Heat only the rooms you need.

Close off unused rooms.

Keep it cool.

Set your thermostat at the lowest comfortable setting. Try 68° or lower.
